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Director's Notes



I'm not actually a Catholic. I did however spend two years in Junior High as the only non-Catholic student at a Francophone school, and did take a catechism course until my parents found out what catéchèse meant and I got to spend that period in the library instead. I did marry a Mexican man though, and Mexican culture does take Catholicism seriously. I also once got into trouble creating chaos as an 8-year-old in the Sistine Chapel. Close enough, I guess.

Nunsense is, of course, a totally ridiculous farce. Don't think too carefully about it, just go for the ride. It's the insane brainchild of Dan Goggin, who based it on his line of rather shocking Nun-related greeting cards. It is off-Broadway's third longestrunning musical, spawning six sequels. It's been translated into 21 languages – and we're thrilled

to be (arguably) the first production to use newly-revised lyrics that happily eschew some rather dated and offensive terms and tropes.

The show is a huge send up of Catholic nuns, their practices and routines but – importantly – not their faith. There are some genuine heartfelt moments in the show, and these insane Sisters all are devout in their own ways, ways that embrace and include people from all beliefs and cultures by bringing to the fore the basic humanity and foibles we all share. Catholicism and any organized religion or belief system can take a lesson from these Sisters as they tackle their temptations with a time step.

We're excited to present two very different casts for this show – I've encouraged each of the performers to discover their own takes on the characters and the result is the same show, told in two quite distinct manners. I'm happy to say that each cast is the other's biggest cheerleaders and supporters. Two casts of five have quickly become a family of ten, plus all the other team members it takes to bring a little show like ours to life.

Enjoy Nunsense, and we hope you'll find it habit-forming. Avoid the vichyssoise.

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

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
