DIRECTOR'S NOTES

My job as director becomes an easy one when I'm able to assemble a team and cast a show with the perfect people. Seriously. Heck, with this cast, half the time there is no actual acting involved – they're simply being themselves using the words provided by the script.

I've been blessed with the show to have had an enormous number of people auditioning. It's been a bittersweet and heart-breaking decision-making process, but one which produced a cast I am so proud of and impressed with. I also had many people on the production side of things wanting to be a part of this show and whose dedication and love shine through on all aspects, from sets to choreography to our amazing musicians and musical director, from props to backstage crew to lighting and costumes, stage management, sound, projections — not to mention the invaluable mentorship from our master puppeteer, Michelle.

Avenue Q has become an iconic show, and has developed a cult following, particularly with young adults seeking their purpose; those who remember having been those selfsame young adults; and those who are not quite so young but who are still searching for a purpose of their own.

Over the last close to fifty years, a couple generations have been shaped and taught by *Sesame Street* and the many programs inspired by it. We learned the fundamentals of how to move through childhood and into young adulthood. *Avenue Q* takes the next step, teaching the graduates of children's television the art of adulting. Or tries to.

Yes, the quick elevator pitch for *Avenue Q* is "Sesame Street on the wrong side of the tracks." But it is also a show with a monumental amount of heart, and inevitably those who see it will find themselves reflected any number of times in these characters.






ALEXANDRA MAY (SET PAINTING)
